

Terms and Conditions for the Goodbye Christopher Robin Prize Draw

1. The Hamptons International Goodbye Christopher Robin Prize Draw (“the Prize Draw”) is offered by Hamptons International, a trading name of Countrywide Estate Agents (“the Promoter”), registered at Countrywide House, 88-103 Caldecotte Lake Drive, Caldecotte, Milton Keynes, Buckinghamshire, MK7 8JT.
2. The Prize Draw is open to eligible customers only. Eligible customers are those who:
 - Are aged 18 or older; and
 - Who are a visitor at the Roadshow on Saturday 14th October (“the Event”).

Employees of the Promoter, their families, agents or any third party directly associated with administration of the Prize Draw are excluded. Proof of age and identity may be required.
3. The Prize Draw is free to enter and no purchase is necessary.
4. Every person who participates in the Promoter’s online data entry exercise by completing the form found on the back of the Roadshow ticket and who gives the completed form to a representative of the Promoter at the Event will be automatically entered into the Prize Draw.
5. Entrants can enter the Prize Draw only once. Multiple entries will be discarded and not considered.
6. Entry to the Prize Draw will open at the Event at 9am on Saturday 14th October. The closing date of the Prize Draw is at 6pm on Saturday 14th October.
7. One winner will receive a luxury trip to Tunbridge Wells for two people (“the Prize”). The winner and their guest will receive:
 - Return mainland UK train travel to Tunbridge Wells;
 - Return station transfers in Tunbridge Wells;
 - 2 nights’ luxury (4*min) hotel accommodation in Tunbridge Wells, based on sharing a double/twin room or quadruple occupancy room;
 - Chef’s tasting menu with wine pairing at top fine-dining restaurant in Tunbridge Wells, to the maximum value of £128pp;
 - A trip to Ashdown Forest including:
 - Afternoon Tea Picnic in the Hotel’s Grounds, set menu to the maximum value of £24.50pp;
 - Full day bike hire;
 - Return transfers from Tunbridge Wells.

The Prize is subject to availability. The Ashdown Forest picnic is available from April to September. If the winner chooses to travel outside of this time then an alternative activity of equal value will be offered by the Supplier.
8. At least one traveller must be aged 18 or over. Where any travellers are aged under 18, they must have prior parental or guardian permission. Alcohol will not be served to guests aged under 18.
9. The hotel will be selected by the Supplier at their sole discretion. A valid credit or debit card will be required for security deposit purposes when checking into hotel accommodation.
10. The Prize excludes meals and drinks, excursions, attractions, treatments, car hire, visas and personal expenses and anything not expressly stated to be included in the Prize. Any other costs incurred in addition to those set out above and that are incidental to the fulfilment of the Prize are the responsibility of the winner and their guest.
11. The Prize will be supplied by Element (“the Supplier”).

12. One winner will be chosen by random draw supervised by an independent person on [Monday 23rd October] "Draw Date").
13. The Promoter will contact the winner by telephone or email within [10] days after the Draw Date, using the telephone number and/or email address provided at entry. If the winner does not respond to the Promoter within twenty (20) calendar days of being notified by the Promoter, then the winner's prize will be forfeited and the Promoter will be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process described above.
14. The winner must give the Supplier at least six (6) weeks' notice prior to their preferred departure date. The winner will be requested to provide three separate dates of preferred travel. Once confirmed in writing, travel dates and names of those traveling are not changeable.
15. The winner must go on the trip within twelve (12) months of winning the Prize. If the winner does not travel within twelve (12) months of the Draw Date they will no longer be entitled to the Prize and the Prize will be considered null and void. The Prize cannot be taken from 21st December 2017 – 2nd January 2018 (Christmas and New Year), over UK bank holidays, or over Easter Sunday. The stay must include a Saturday night at the hotel.
16. The Prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable and no cash alternative is offered.
17. The Promoter or Supplier reserves the right to replace the Prize with an alternative prize of equal or higher value if circumstances beyond their control make it necessary to do so.
18. The decision of the Promoter regarding any aspect of the Prize Draw is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into about it.
19. The winner's name and county can be obtained by sending a stamped addressed envelope to Marketing Department, United Kingdom House, 180 Oxford Street, London, W1D 1NN within one (1) month of the Draw Date.
20. Participants are deemed to have accepted and agreed to be bound by these terms and conditions upon entry. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse entry, or refuse to award the Prize to anyone in breach of these terms and conditions.
21. Insofar as is permitted by law, the Promoter, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the Prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the Promoter, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.
22. The Promoter reserves the right to hold void, cancel, suspend, or amend the Prize Draw without notice where it becomes necessary to do so.
23. Personal data supplied during the course of this promotion may be used by the Promoter and passed on to the Supplier or other third party suppliers only insofar as required for fulfilment/delivery/arrangement of the Prize.
24. Winners may be required to participate in publicity related to the Prize Draw which may include the publication of their name and photograph in any media.
25. The Prize Draw will be governed by English law and entrants to the Prize Draw submit to the jurisdiction of the English courts.
