

Terms and Conditions for the Cancer Research Prize Draw

1. The Cancer Research Prize Draw (“the Prize Draw”) is offered by Hamptons International, a trading name of Countrywide Estate Agents, whose registered address is at Hamptons International Greenwood House, 1st Floor, 91-99 New London Road, Chelmsford, Essex, CM2 0PP. (the Promoter”).
2. Entry into the Prize Draw shall open on 31 July 2019 at 09:00 hrs (BST) and will close at 16:00 hrs (BST) on 10 August 2019 (“Closing Date”). Entries received outside of these dates and times will not be valid but any donation made on entry will still be processed.
3. Entry into the Prize Draw is open to eligible entrants only. An eligible entrant is one who is a UK resident who is aged 18 years or over excluding employees of the Promoter and any persons who are connected in any way to this Prize Draw (“Entrant”). Proof of age and identity may be required.
4. Entries are made by either:
 - (a) Making a donation of £1.00 or more in-store at a participating Hamptons International branch. You will be required to provide your name, telephone number and email address (“Contact Details”). You will be entered into the draw once for every £1 you donate (e.g. £3 will buy you three entries into the Prize Draw but £3.50 will also buy you three entries). The amount donated will be the cost of entering the Prize Draw; or
 - (b) Sending your Contact Details via post to: Gabriella Farrow, Countrywide PLC, Standon House, First floor, 21 Mansell Street, London E1 8AA (“Entry Route B”). You must also provide your postal address in order to receive your ticket and unique entry number. This form of entry is your free entry route but you are responsible for the cost of postage. Postal entries must be received by the Closing Date. You will be entered into the Prize Draw once for every postal entry you send.

You must consent to your Contact Details being used for the purposes of the Prize Draw. Once an entry has been submitted it cannot be withdrawn or refunded.

5. The Promoter does not accept any responsibility for entries that are lost, late or incomplete or have not been received due to any error beyond Hampton’s reasonable control. Proof of sending is not proof of receipt.
6. Entrants will receive a ticket containing their unique entry number(s) and entered into the Prize Draw whereby the first 13 unique entry numbers drawn at random from all eligible entries received will be the winning entries.

Prizes will be drawn in order – first prize will be drawn first, second prize second, third prize third and will continue in this sequence until all prizes have been drawn. 8. Each winner of the Prize Draw will be notified using the Contact Details they provided within 7 days of the draw date. Winners will need to arrange to collect their prize from Hamptons International, 82 Church road, Hove, BN3 2EB.
9. If a winner does not reply within 7 days of the notification email in accordance with paragraph 9, he or she will forfeit the prize and another winner will be selected from the remaining eligible entries in

accordance with the above process until a winner is selected and can be contacted.

10. The prize is not transferable and not exchangeable for cash or any other prize and if any prize is not available, The Promoter reserves the right to offer an alternative prize of a similar value.
11. The Promoter may name the winners of the Prize Draw in subsequent related press releases and on their website. A list of winners (including their name and county) shall be available on request 30 days after the closing date by sending an email requesting the list to: farrowg@cwllondon.co.uk. By entering the Prize Draw, you agree to your name being used in this way.
12. The prizes are being supplied by external donators/suppliers ("Donors"). If you encounter any problems with the enjoyment of a prize, please contact the Donor in the first instance. The Donor's terms and conditions will apply to the prize. Please contact the Donor for a copy of the Donor's terms and conditions and only accept a prize if you are happy to accept the Donor's terms and conditions. The Promoter gives no guarantee or warranty regarding the prizes.
13. The prizes will also be subject to Donors' exclusions and additional eligibility requirements. For example, prizes may need to be enjoyed on specific dates, winners may need a valid passport/driving licence etc. Please contact the Donor of the prize for information on the eligibility requirements and only accept a prize if you are happy to accept the Donor's exclusions and eligibility requirements.
14. In the event of unforeseen circumstances, The Promoter reserves the right to amend or withdraw the Prize Draw at any time.
15. The only personal data The Promoter will process about you for the purposes of the Prize Draw are your Contact Details and if you are a winner, your address for the delivery of your prize ("your personal data"). The Promoter will process your personal data fairly and lawfully and in accordance with the principles of the Data Protection Act 2018. Save where required by law or court order to share your personal data with a third party, the police or other law enforcement authorities, The Promoter will only use your personal data for the administration of the Prize Draw, will not share your personal data with third parties (except for the winners, whose Contact Details may be passed to the Donor to enable the winner to enjoy the prize) and will destroy your personal data within 12 months of the completion of the Prize Draw.
16. All proceeds of the Prize Draw will go to CRUK (Charity Registration Number in England and Wales [1089464])
17. By entering the Prize Draw the Entrant accepts and agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.
18. The Promoter's decision on the Prize Draw shall be final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.
19. These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by the laws of England and Wales but you may be able to apply the laws in your country of domicile if you live outside of England and Wales. The courts of England and Wales shall have non-exclusive jurisdiction.
